Take the Saint-Émilion scenic route and admire the iconic Château Angelus and its vineyards. These sought-after wines can be enjoyed at Angelus' inn and restaurant, the Logis de la Cadène. Founded in 1848, it is the oldest restaurant in Saint-Émilion. Stéphanie de Boüard-Rivoal, Chairwoman of Angelus, was drawn to this property due to its close ties to the history of Saint-Émilion. Today, it is a gastronomic restaurant, a charming hotel with eight rooms and suites, and a private mansion deeply rooted in its

terroir and history. The Logis de la Cadène is located on a small square in the heart of the medieval village, which was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1999. Under the leadership of Chef Thibaut Gamba, the Logis de la Cadène has been awarded one Michelin star. Chef Gamba creates elegant and inspired cuisine, focusing resolutely on plant-based and seafood dishes, which pair beautifully with Angelus wines.

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
